ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to form a Task Force to be known as "The Fresh Pond Commission" comprised of members of the Water Board, the Superintendent of the Water Department, representatives of the Recreation Board, the Superintendent of the Recreation Department, a representative of the Conservation Commission and the Head of the Forestry Division of the Public Works Department for the following purposes:

1. To conduct a comprehensive plan of action to clear all areas of the Fresh Pond Reservation for recreation wherever possible.
2. To engage the services of qualified professional personnel to eliminate the present uncontrolled vegetation along the Huron Avenue perimeter of the reservation from the Golf Course Club House to the Aberdeen Avenue bridge.
3. To eliminate the uncontrolled growth of shrubbery and trees inside the fence around the perimeter of the Pond and in the areas immediately adjacent to the Golf Course which growth has reached jungle proportions.
4. To provide the personnel charged with the maintenance of the reservation with the proper equipment to control and beautify the reservation.
5. To develop new areas for picnics and other forms of recreation.
6. To arrange for a round-the-clock security patrol for the safety of the citizens of Cambridge who use this facility for hiking, biking and running.

Referred to the City Solicitor for report on the legal issues involved.
