WHEREAS: The intersection of Cushing Street and Huron Avenue is lacking in visual appeal, and has many safety concerns; and

WHEREAS: Restructuring this intersection would encourage safety driving habits, and provide a logical foot path for pedestrians; and

WHEREAS: The expanse of asphalt between Fresh Pond Place and 650 Huron Avenue is 180 feet wide, which is 140 feet wider than the regular width of Cushing Street, causing cars to enter onto the street at speeds significantly higher than safety would allow; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the intersection of Huron Avenue and Cushing be improved by installing necks that extend out from both sides of Cushing Street, similar to those which were installed at the intersection of Sparks Street and Huron Avenue with brick sidewalks and trees, which will not only slow down vehicular traffic but will also provide an area where the neighborhood people could rest on the way to the new Haggerty School and will provide a much more attractive entrance to the Strawberry Hill neighborhood, and a safer intersection for both pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council as soon as possible.

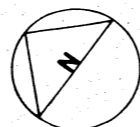
