WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the public safety and convenience require that Lincoln street, from Elm street to Webster Avenue,—Antrim street, from Broadway to Cambridge street,—Cottage street, from Magazine street to Pearl street,—Charles street, from Third street to Fifth street,—Fifth street, from Gore street to Winter street,—Fifth street, from Spring street to Charles street,—and Mellen street from North Avenue to Oxford street, should be laid out as public streets; said Lincoln, Antrim and Cottage streets forty-feet in width, and said Charles, Fifth and Mellen streets, fifty feet in width.

It is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That due notice be given to the abutters on said streets, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to lay out the streets before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as public streets—and that
