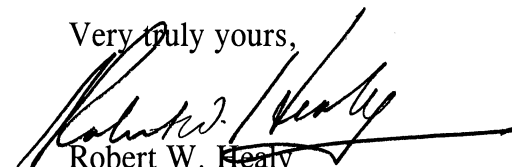

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item Nos. 4 and 6, regarding a report on renovations to the women's bathroom and information on the relocation of City offices for renovations, Public Works Commissioner Ralph Dunphy reports the following:

The renovations to the Personnel Department office and the women's restroom on the third floor are complete. Future planning is underway to convert the second floor men's room into the women's restroom and then changing the third floor restroom into a men's room.

Additional renovations to City Hall are on two separate tracks - - the larger City Hall Phase II major renovations, and the program of in-house renovations of departmental office space.

City Hall Phase II renovations will include masonry restorations, upgrades to heating, plumbing and electrical systems, window restorations, fire detection and fire protection in the attic, installation of additional stairwell as a second means of egress, site work to provide additional parking in the rear of City Hall and renovations to common areas such as hallways and stairwells. A design selection process will begin within the next month following by design development during the Summer with bidding and construction in Fall of 1998.
