WHEREAS:-

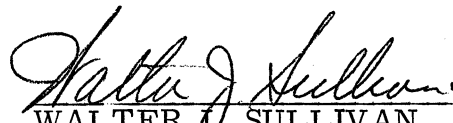
It behooves parents and administrators alike to encourage our young men and women to enter into this very worthwhile profession; now therefore be it
