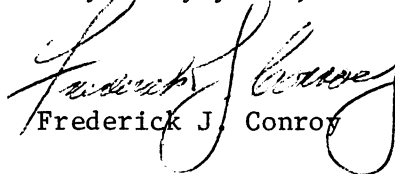

I would like to bring to your attention a dangerous situation on Mount Auburn Street in front of the property numbered 116-118 Mount Auburn Street. Directly in front of the restaurant a trench was constructed to install municipal utilities. Since the repair of the street, settlement has occurred in a large area. Buses and trucks going over the area make heavy bumps shaking the building causing dishes, glasses, cups, and the like to shake on the tables. In addition, water collects in the depressed area which splashes on pedestrians using the sidewalk if they are unfortunate to be there when a bus, truck or car goes by.
