In Board of Aldermen, May 11 1870

Whereas it is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Clark Street should be extended and laid out as a public Street or way from School Street to Main Street, in accordance with the Report of the Committee on Roads and Bridges, this day submitted to the Board, -

Ordered, That said Clark Street be extended from School Street to Main Street by taking for this purpose 7,888 square feet of land belonging to Estabrook and O. P. Clark, and laying out the same as a Street or public way, by the name of Clark Street, said Street to be forty feet in width, as delineated on a plan drawn by J. C. Chase, City Engineer, dated April 20, 1870, and now before this Board.

Ordered, That damages for the land so taken be estimated and awarded as follows;

To Estabrook & Clark -

\$3,944.50

Ordered, That assessors, Estabrook & Clark,

be allowed to remove the fences, trees, and
loom on the land so taken, and that

60 days be allowed them for removing
the same.
