with all the improvements hurts me very much I now
ask the Hon. Board and Mayor of Cambridge in
the name of the common wealth of Mass. to grant
me a hearing and I will give them the whole particulars
and show them if any statement is not right I
will decide a settlement on the spot and if the city
is wrong in the steps taken I intend that they will
settle there fast and make it right
