Petition of Boston & Maine Railroad for determination by the Department of Public Utilities that the better security of human life and the convenience of the public travel require discontinuance of the present method of protection at its Massachusetts Avenue and Cameron Street crossings in the City of Cambridge be discontinued substituting therefor electric half-gates and flashers with pedestrian bells at both crossings with said devices to be manually controlled from a single location during the same hours that the crossing tender is on duty at present and to make such further order in the premises as public good may require.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing in its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Monday, November 25, 1963 at 10:30 o'clock in the forenoon.
