Marie Sheehan of Arlington, 46, Harvard employee

Marie (McKinnon) Sheehan of Arlington, a coordinator of undergraduate studies at Harvard University, died Saturday at Mount Auburn Hospital in Cambridge following a lengthy illness. She was 46.

Born in Arlington, she graduated from St. Agnes School, Matignon High School, and the University of Massachusetts at Amherst.

Mrs. Sheehan worked for Harvard University for 20 years. She was the coordinator of undergraduate studies for the History of Science Department for the past 11 years.

She is survived by her husband, Michael; three daughters, Kristin, Maggie and Dana, all of Arlington; her mother, Lois McKinnon; two brothers, Paul McKinnon Jr. of Gilford, Conn., and Donald McKinnon of New York; and two sisters, Nancy Kelley of Mashpee and Gail Heinz of Block Island, R.I.
