I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$380,843.00 in the Grant Fund of the Cambridge Police Department's Salary and Wages Account (\$225,313.00), the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$114,500.00) and the Travel and Training Account (\$41,030.00) from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety. This grant has been awarded to the Cambridge Police Department to assist in the implementing a Community Policing strategy in the City.
