- WHEREAS: The theme of this year's observance will be the United States Constitution and the Black American; and
- WHEREAS: This observance will promote increased respect for law and order and a greater understanding of the functioning of democratic institutions; and
- WHEREAS: This observance will also provide an opportunity to assess the progress which has been made in the United States in the areas of government and human rights, particularly among Afro-Americans; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1983 as "National Afro-American History Month" in the City of Cambridge and urge the citizens of Cambridge to recognize this event and participate fittingly in its observance; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council lends its support and endorsement to this proclamation.
