The Cambridge Common will soon be completed, and

WHEREAS:

There will inevitably arise issues about the appropriateness of public, artistic and cultural events on the Cambridge Common; events which caused distress to many Cambridge citizens last year, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to establish a committee to stimulate creative public, artistic and cultural events on the Cambridge Common which would appeal to all Cambridge residents; a committee which would have the additional responsibility of issuing permits for planned events on the common, and would coordinate the supervision of such events, as well as the physical maintenance of the grounds, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the composition of this committee include representatives of the community including residents, businessmen, clergymen, as well as representatives of the City government specifically from the Recreation, Traffic, Police, Public Works, Library and School Departments along with the Youth Resources Bureau, Community Schools, Historical Commission and the Bicentennial Commission, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That it is the sense of this City Council that any musical event on the Cambridge Common not be amplified.
