We are very grateful to Mayor Sullivan and the City Council for their kindness in remembering Father John in this thoughtful action.

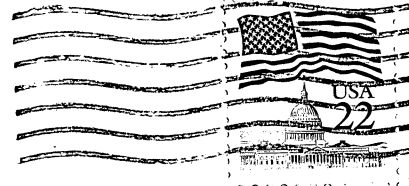

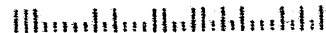
