IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

July 20, 1874.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Kindson Street
from Cambridge St. to land of Boynton Packing Co.
 should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty eight feet*
 in width between

Cambridge St. and land of Boynton Packing Co.

included between the *blue* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

C. A. Bowker

dated June 5, 1874

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for removal
of fences or other obstructions standing thereon.
