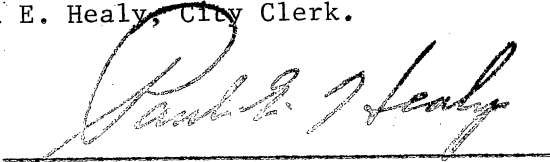
IN CITY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS: The City Council has previously dealt with problems related to the lodging house at 151-153 Auburn Street; and
- WHEREAS: As a result, the City was able to make some progress in that situation, which has been stynied, apparently, since a now owner took over; and
- WHEREAS: The deteriorating conditions of the situation, including the fact the house is operating without a license, causes great concern to the neighbors; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager review the present situation, and recommend actions that would speed up the upgrading of the building to become a properly operating licensed lodging house; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on his findings.
