ORDERED: That the City Manager is once again requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to repair Rindge Avenue from Sherman Street to Alewife Brook Parkway on the St. John's Cemetery side of the street. This section of Rindge Avenue accumulates an excessive amount of water after rain storms. It should be noted that this is one of the most heavily traveled walking routes for school aged children in the city. The accumulated water has resulted in children spending the school day in wet clothing at the result of being splashed by passing vehicles. He is further
