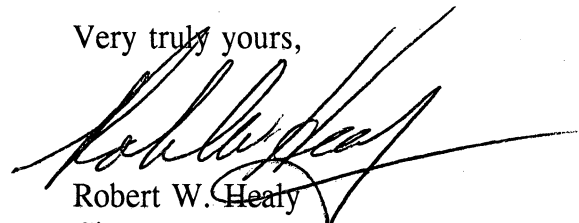
In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 15, regarding the hazardous traffic situation at Richdale Avenue from Raymond Street, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department has investigated the intersection of Richdale Avenue and Raymond Street. Raymond Street is stopped due to the limited sight distance caused by the angle of the intersection and the building at the back of the narrow sidewalk. In order to increase the maneuverability and guidance at this intersection the Department will take the following steps:

1. Restrict parking along the north side of Richdale Avenue about 80 feet with the loss of 2 parking spaces;
2. restrict parking along the south side of Richdale Avenue 20 feet with no loss of legal parking; and
3. paint a yellow dash line from Richdale Avenue to Raymond Street to guide drivers as they make the turn.

This should be completed by October 3, 1997.
