- WHEREAS: This Councillor assured them that their concerns would be addressed by the entire City Council and the various departments concerned; therefore let it be
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager direct the appropriate department heads to:
- #1. Check the "Walk" and "Don't Walk" signals at the corner of Rindge Avenue and Sherman Street to determine whether they are working properly.
 - #2. Study the intersection of Dudley and Cedar Street to determine whether a pedestrian light should be installed to ensure the safety of the children using the playground.
 - #3. Clear the basketball courts, tennis courts racketball courts and ice skating rink at Rindge Park of glass and debris, and report back to this City Council, so that we may notify this concerned Girl Scout Troop, that our city government acts for them.
