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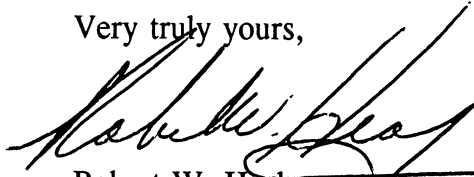

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 7 regarding the "Lost Zebra," please be advised that Pallas Lombardi, Acting Director of the Arts Council, proposes that FY94 percent for the arts funds be used to pay the artist, Patricia Keck, \$5,000 to build a new Zebra. Cambridge Police have volunteered to provide surveillance of the new structure; they believe that the unusual vandalism to the first Zebra was deliberately perpetrated by an adult.

I understand that students from the Tobin School have debated the issue of the Lost Zebra and are making recommendations to the Council. I have requested the Arts Council to inform them that the City will fund a new one and will have it back in their community by this Fall.
