To the Honorable, the City Council:

I want to take this occasion to respond to City Council orders of February 4, 1974.

Please be advised that Council Order No. 1 relating to the matter of the repairs or rehabilitation of the underpass located between Yerxa Road and Raymond Streets, has been referred to the Commissioner of Public Works and the work has been undertaken. I have instructed the Commissioner of Public Works who is performing this work to see to it that periodic checks are made on this installation to assure pedestrian accessibility at all times.

Please be advised that Council Order No. 2 is being explored at this time by myself and the Chief of Police and also a representative of the Telephone Company. Further information on this order will be forthcoming in the near future.

Council Orders No. 3 and No. 4 appear to be the responsibility of the City Clerk and I will be helpful to him on this matter if he so requests.

Council Order No. 4 is a more complex problem and I wish your Honorable Body to know that I have arranged a meeting with the following persons to discuss this matter next week -

I will make it a point to involve the School Committee in this same discussion at a later point in time.

I am sure that Council Order No. 7 has been appropriately satisfied.


