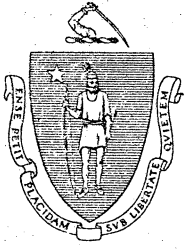

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At a meeting of the Emergency Finance Board of the Commonwealth, held on the 21st day of September, 1972, a majority of said Board being present, the following vote was passed:

VOTED: That in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3A) of the General Laws, as amended, approval is hereby given to the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE for the borrowing of TWO MILLION, SIX HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,650,000.00) for the purpose of Remodeling, Reconstructing or Making Extraordinary Repairs to the Home for the Aged and Infirm, as authorized by vote of the City Council on July 20th, 1972. The term of the loan is not to exceed Ten (10) Years.
