WHEREAS:-

The City Council on February 22, 1971 adopted Chapter 835 of the Acts of 1970, now known as Chapter 41, Section 108L of the General Laws, the same being An Act establishing a career incentive pay program for regular full-time police officers and providing for partial reimbursements by the Commonwealth for certain cities and towns, and

WHEREAS:-

The City Council by order adopted on November 15, 1971 requested the City Manager to implement the provisions of this legislation which provides for career incentive salary increases for police officers and reimbursement by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for 50% of the cost of said increases upon certification by the Board of Higher Education from information filed before September 1st of each year with said board as furnished by the Chief of the Police Department, and

WHEREAS:-

A considerable amount of time has elapsed and the career incentive salary increases for police officers has not been received by the police officers to enroll in this program, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Chief of Police and the City Treasurer to take the necessary action to carry out the provisions of Chapter 835 of the Acts of 1970, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council the action taken by him pursuant to this order prior to January 24, 1972
