To the Honorable, the City Council
of the City of Cambridge,

Gentlemen:-

In asking for favorable action on the petition of my co-trustees and myself for a modification of the restrictions on the lands at the junction of Main Street and the Esplanade, at the hearings before the Committee on Public Property and later to a number of the members of the Council, I stated that I believed such action would result in the early erection of a building or buildings on those and the adjoining lands, - buildings which, beside materially increasing the taxable property of the City, would be devoted, in part, at least, to recreation purposes, thus increasing the use and enjoyment of the Basin, - a development much desired by the Park Commission.

During the past week conditions have arisen which make the situation so doubtful that I am unwilling any longer to be sponsor for the carrying out of the project.

I trust that, in due time, the order reported by the Committee on Public Property will be favorably acted upon, - so that, if the present project fails, the same obstacle will not again interfere with some improvement of the lands.

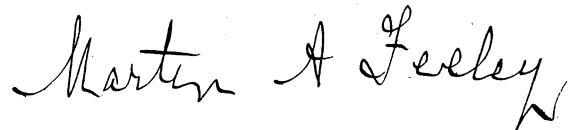
