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To the City Clerk of Cambridge:

CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

We, as citizens and tenants of Cambridge, are very concerned with statements made by members of the Rent Control Board concerning implementation of the 1967 Rent Control Law.

Members of the Rent Control Board have made statements to the effect that: 1) Landlords who have bought property after 1967 would be exempt from the 1967 plus 30 per cent rent formula. Also, that 2) this formula does not apply where application of the 130 per cent formula would result in decreases in the tenants' rent relative to the 1970 level.

We feel these statements are incorrect and reflect a prejudicial and discriminatory attitude on the part of the Rent Control Board, and certainly requires public hearing.

Therefore, we petition the Mayor and the City Council to include a discussion of this important issue, early on the agenda of the Monday, February 26th meeting of the City Council.
