COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: In constructing the new cement sidewalk along Rice Street it was necessary to dig up an approximately two foot length of driveway and walkway on the property of the owner/resident at 77 Rice Street. The subsequent asphalt patching of both areas was done in such a way that the prior hole in the prior asphalt surface, which would allow for the insertion of the steel rod for locking the driveway gate, was covered over with the result that the gate cannot now be locked, thereby creating a safety hazard when the owner's grandchildren come to visit. In addition, on both the driveway and the walkway, the uneven settling of the asphalt patches is such that with the coming frost and cold, additional depression at both sites will occur and result in the presence of puddling and icing with the safety risks related thereto; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Department of Public Works Commissioner to examine this dual complaint and take whatever steps are necessary to remedy the problems as soon as possible; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the City Council on this matter within two weeks.
