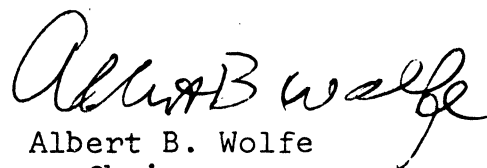

To the owners of property in the Longfellow Park
Historic District in the vicinity of 108 Brattle Street:

Our Commission has received an application from Thaddeus R. Beal, owner of 108 Brattle Street, for an application for a certificate of appropriateness to remove a chimney over the one-story room at the right rear of the house, as seen from Brattle Street. The chimney is no longer in use and is in disrepair.

Under the Historic Districts Act (G.L. Chapter 40C, as amended by Acts of 1971, Chapter 359) we may dispense with public hearing if we deem the features involved insubstantial in effect on the District and if we give 10 days prior notice to owners of property adjoining and which we deem materially affected. We deem the effect insubstantial and your properties those affected.

Please notify us of any objection to our issuing the requested Certificate after a lapse of 10 days.
