To the Honorable the Mayor and Aldermen,  
Gentlemen.

The City Engineer, to whom was referred so much of the petition of James Hawkes as relates to the line of East St., reports that he has complied with said reference by furnishing the desired information to said petitioner.

In connection with the lines of the street herein considered, it becomes my farther duty, under Sec. 3 of the ordinance for maintaining the lines of streets, to report that a brick building has recently been constructed and is now in process of completion, upon the Westery side of said East St., at the corner of North St., the South Easterly corner of which, has been so placed as to encroach upon the street ten inches. The parties owning this property are Messrs. John Towne & Son, No. 53 Leverett St. Boston, who have never applied, at this office, for in-

formation upon the lines of said street.

Also, upon the Easterly side of said street, Mr. S. A. Holt has placed the foundations for a large building so as to project into the street, at the Northerly corner six and one half inches, and at the Southerly corner fourteen and one quarter inches. Mr. Holt had not applied for the line of the street, but, upon being informed of the condition of his work and the correct line, which I have this day furnished, satisfactory assurance was given that the contemplated structure shall at once be made to conform to the line designated.

The former encroachment requires the passage of the order referred to in said section of said ordinance.
