- WHEREAS: Along with the many activities John and Marie were two of the original founders of the Drum and Bugle Corp known as the Cambridge Caballeros which was famous for its musical talent during the 1950's and 1960's; and
- WHEREAS: John and Marie have three children, Sheila, John and Thomas, all of whom have looked upon their parents as role models and who have blessed them with nine grandchildren; now therefore be it
