WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a petition dated November 17, 1983 from Irving Fischman, Trustee, Putnam Court Real Estate Trust, et al, requesting that the private way described in the "Master Declaration of Covenants, Easements, Restrictions and Conditions Creating a Common Scheme" filed at the Middlesex County Registry of Deeds, Book 14672, Page 294 and indicated on the plan entitled "Plan of Land in Cambridge, Massachusetts, Fort Washington Townhouse Subdivision" dated February 24, 1982 and drawn by Frederick R. Joyce, Co., Registered Land Surveyors (the "Plan") which Plan is recorded at the Middlesex County Registry of Deeds, Plan #609 of 1982, Book 14655, Page 364, Described as follows:

The "Driveway" referred to in the Master Declaration is the driveway extending from Sidney Street to Putnam Court the paved width of which is a minimum of eighteen (18) feet wide and is located within the strip of land the Southwesterly line of which is the Southwesterly boundary of lots 1,3,4 and 5 abutting land N/F G. Kaldro and the extension thereof to said Putnam Court and the Northeasterly line of which is parallel to said Southwesterly line and nineteen and 37/100 (19.37) feet distant Northeasterly therefrom and extends from said Sidney Street to said Putnam Court

; and

WHEREAS: This petition has been approved by the City Solicitor by communication dated January 6, 1984 and by Joan Lastovica, City Engineer by communication dated December 8, 1983, indicating their approval of the petition as submitted; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council acting under the authority of Chapter 85, Section 3A of the Massachusetts General Laws and Section 17-6 of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge hereby designates that said Driveway shall be henceforth known as Fort Washington Place and that lots 1,7,9,10,11,12,13,14,15 and 16 be numbered 1,11,2,4,6,8,10, 12,14, and 16 Fort Washington Place respectively.

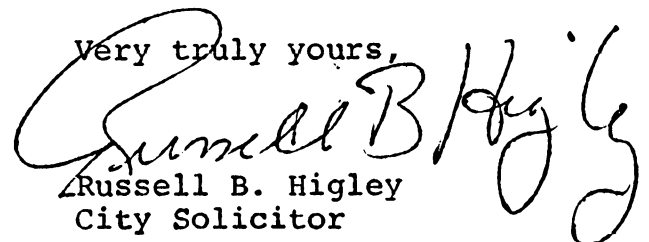
Dear Mr. Healy:

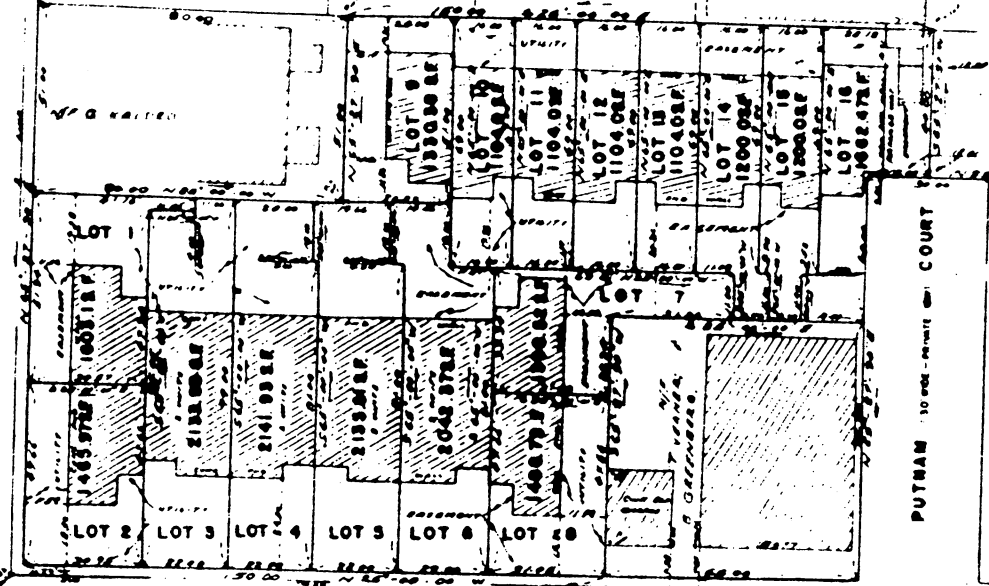

100' WIDE - PUBLIC WAY

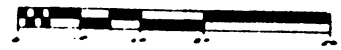
