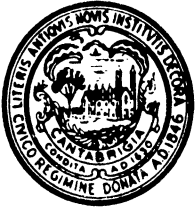

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$26,049.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Service Programs Salary and Wages Account (\$2,000.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$24,049.00). The Low Income Sewer and Water Assistance Program (LISAWAP), operated by the Department of Human Services, is available to Cambridge and Somerville homeowners whose income falls at or below the 150% of poverty according to Federal guidelines. Eligible clients can receive 25% or \$200, whichever is less, toward their annual water and sewer bill. The funding is provided by the Massachusetts Department of Community Development.
