Most Reverend Humberto S. Medeiros has been selected by the Holy See to be the seventh Archbishop of Boston and Spiritual Leader of the two million Roman Catholics in the Boston Archdiocese, and

WHEREAS:-

Most Reverent Luigi Raimondi, Apostolic Delegate to the United States, and personal representative of Pope Paul VI in the United States, will be the principal celebrant of the Installation Mass at Holy Cross Cathedral in Boston on October 7, 1970, and

WHEREAS:-

Bishop Medeiros was born in the Village of Arrifes in the Azores, the son of immigrant parents who settled in the City of Fall River, and distinguished himself in his priestly vocation by his friendship for the friendless and his love of the working man whom he followed into the fields of Texas ministering to their needs and becoming an outspoken advocate in their struggles to obtain fair treatment and their just rewards for their labors, therefore be it

That this City Council go on record congratulating Archbishop-elect Humberto S. Medeiros as he assumes his new duties as the successor to Cardinal Cushing as the Spiritual Leader of the Boston Archdiocese, and be it further
