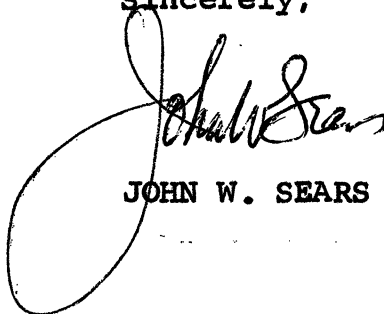

The Metropolitan District Commission would like to inform the Cambridge community that we have marked eight (8) trees on Memorial Drive fronting on the Cambridge embankment in an area between Western Avenue Bridge and Longfellow Bridge for removal. These trees are dead or in a state of near death and are deemed dangerous to the public.

The cutting of the trees does not indicate that the M.D.C. has any other project in mind; the removal is a park maintenance program in the Charles River Reservation.
