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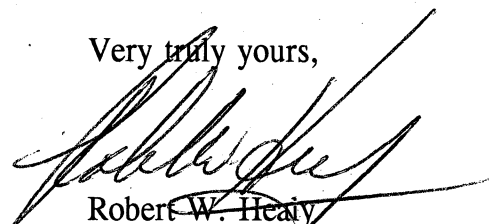

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 29, regarding a review of the additional handicapped parking space behind City Hall, Deputy Traffic Director Lauren M. Preston reports the following:

On January 28, 1994, the Traffic Department received a request from the Commission for Persons with Disabilities to relocate the H.P. spaces behind City Hall so that they would be more accessible, especially for lift-equipped vans. After several discussions with the Commission, it was agreed that one van accessible H.P. space would be installed on Dottie Doyle Way. This will allow good access since H.P. vans are generally exited on the right (passenger) side. The number of H.P. spaces at City Hall will remain at two with the other space in the well posted as 10-minute live parking only.
