TO: George Tiso, Commissioner of Traffic and Parking, City of
Cambridge, Massachusetts

The undersigned live in the Avon Hill Area of Cambridge,
Massachusetts (the area bounded by Linnaean Street, Avon Hill
Street, Upland Road, and Massachusetts Avenue).

As a result of the activities of Lesley College at 49
Washington Avenue, the Avon Hill Area is being harmed by
excessive traffic and demand for parking spaces.

Such traffic is a safety hazard, causes noise and air
pollution, hurts property values, and diminishes the quality
of life in the residential neighborhood. There is widespread
indignation.

THEREFORE the undersigned request that a system of resident
"sticker" parking be imposed without delay in the Avon Hill
Area.
