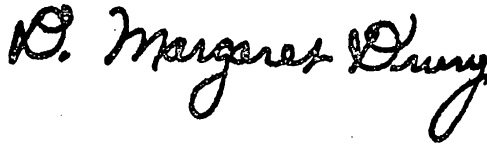

WHEREAS: William Westmoreland was a retired U.S. Army General having served in WWII, Korea and Vietnam; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland was a 1936 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland was the Superintendent of the United States Military Academy at West Point from 1960-1963; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland was the Commander of the U.S. Forces in Vietnam from 1964-1968; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland was the United States Army's Chief of Staff from 1968 until his retirement in 1972; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife, Katherine "Kitzy" (Van Deusen), his son "Rip", and his daughters, Katherine and Margaret; and

WHEREAS: General Westmoreland will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
