The undersigned respectfully pray

That in order to clear the title of your petitioners, Alice E. Altmiller and Clara T. Altmiller of Cambridge to the lot of land on Vassal Lane and shown as lot No. 103 on Assessors Block Plan No. 233, the Mayor be authorized in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge to execute and deliver to said petitioners a deed in proper form to said lot.

This lot assessed in 1908 in name of Charles A. Mason was sold for unpaid taxes and bought by the City of Cambridge and deed recorded with Middlesex South District Deeds Book 3450, Page 451.

The original tax on this land amounted to \$8.04 and on May 23, 1928 Alice E. and Clara T. Altmiller, the successors in title, paid to the City of Cambridge \$37.54 the amount necessary to discharge the lien, and received a release thereof from the City Treasurer. The taxes assessed each year since 1908 had been duly paid to the City of Cambridge.

Our conveyancer advises us the deed requested in this petition is necessary to clear our title.
