The undersigned respectfully pray

CONCERNED CITIZENS ON I-190 BE GRANTED PERMISSION TO SPONSOR ITS SECOND ANNUAL WALK FOR WATER ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 17, 1976, TO RAISE MONEY FOR LEGAL EXPENSES IN ITS EFFORTS TO HALT CONSTRUCTION OF I-190 THROUGH THE WACHUSETTS WATERSHED. THIS SYSTEM SUPPLIES WATER TO OVER 3 1/2 MILLION MASSACHUSETTS RESIDENTS, INCLUDING CAMBRIDGE RESIDENTS.

THE WALK WILL BEGIN AT 1:00 P.M. AND ABOUT 200 MARCHERS ARE EXPECTED. WALKERS WILL MEET ON PLEASANT STREET AT CONCORD AVENUE IN BELMONT. THEY WILL FOLLOW CONCORD AVENUE TO THE ALEWIFE BROOK PARKWAY, PROCEED ALONG THE PARKWAY TO HARVARD SQUARE IN CAMBRIDGE, THEN WALK UP MASSACHUSETTS AVE TO MAIN STREET. THE MARCH WILL REMAIN ON MAIN STREET TO CAMBRIDGE STREET, AND FOLLOW CAMBRIDGE STREET TO CROSS OVER LONGFELLOW BRIDGE TO BOSTON. THEN IT WILL PROCEED UP CHARLES TO BEACON STREET AND END AT THE STATE HOUSE.
