WHEREAS: Graffiti continues to be an ongoing problem in this city; and

WHEREAS: This Councillor as well as other Councillors have put in many Orders over the past year requesting the administration to take positive action in order to remedy this situation; and

WHEREAS: The Citizens of this City and visitors continue to complain about how unsightly the graffiti is on private property throughout this City; and

WHEREAS: This City Council desires to rid the City of this blight, but at the same time realizes that in addition to police action on this matter, that the private sector must get actively involved; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to set up awards for those Citizens who on their own rid their private property of this graffiti and that said awards be given at a regular scheduled City Council meeting and that all forms of media be notified that said awards will be given and that the City take an inventory of the owners of graffiti ridden property and notify them that they will be eligible for this recognition if they remove the graffiti by a certain date. Further, that the City Manager be further ordered to report back to the City Council by October 3, 1994 as to whether or not he will implement such a program.
