- 2. Commend the Mid Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation Commission, chair John Moos, and members (get names from Charlie Sullivan or staff).... on the fair, thoughtful and professional manner in which the Mid Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation Commission organized and conducted the public process for the review of Harvard's Knafel Center, a process which will serve as the model for other such reviews for many years to come.

3. That the CM be and hereby is requested, in the interests of democracy and ensuring a fair, well-informed, and public process, to release the reports from consultants regarding the site selection for a new library, including professional cost estimates for the two sites under consideration, to the public and especially to the media, including the local press, in a time frame ample enough to allow publication and/or coverage of such reports in the local press for the purpose of informing the public of the full range of issues, in advance of any Council action on the library site selection.
