Dear Ms Drury, Clerk of the City of Cambridge:

Please promptly bring to the attention of your employers, the members of the Cambridge City Council this notice that I intend to sue each one of them personally and in their official capacities if they violate my rights under Council Rule 23 and Chapter 43 section 9B of the Massachusetts General laws to be heard on the subject matter of my September 14, 1992 letter. tonight at the September 21, 1992 regular city council meeting. Please provide each council member with a copy of Councillor Walsh's Consent Order #20 and #23 referred to in my September 14, 1992 letter. My matters are to be heard under old business and before any new business is considered by the council. Further, should the city council fail and refuse to discontinue to interfere with my right as a complainant against Continental Cablevision and the officers, Board members and employees of Cambridge Community Television under Gen law 166A: 10, 11, 18, 19 and the City's Cable TV license or the city manager refuses to appoint me to the position of cable commissioner for the city of Cambridge I will bring an action in the Supreme Judicial Court against the City of Cambridge, its city council, its law department and its city manager for injunctive relief and money damages
