To the Honorable, the City Council:

With regard to meeting with representatives of Harvard Community Health Plan, given the current delicacy in negotiations, representatives from the Harvard Community Health Plan and the City have requested that any hearing concerning the role of HCHP with Cambridge Hospital be postponed until the Fall. The current negotiations are proceeding in a satisfactory manner, with progress being made in areas of both an expanded general business relationship between HCHP and Cambridge Hospital and in allowing City of Cambridge employees who are members of HCHP to elect to use Cambridge Hospital for general admissions. On this basis, it is recommended that no hearing be held at this time until negotiations are closer to completion.
