WHEREAS: The Jewish War Veterans of the United States of America Post #35, located in Temple Beth Shalom in Cambridge, has in conjunction with its Auxiliary, provided such notable public and human services as its "Classmates Today, Neighbors Tomorrow" program for high school students, its Child Welfare and Senior Citizens programs, its Veterans Hospitals and Soldiers Homes visitation programs and the sponsoring of holiday parties at those institutions, its program to assist disabled veterans to various sporting events, its generous program of donations of televisions, radios, cameras and the like for the use of the handicapped and the disadvantaged to help such persons improve the quality of their lives, and its participation in the public, historic and patriotic celebrations of our City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: The said Post #35 is known for its persistent and enduring sense of charity and public spirit and will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary this year; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge recognizes the Jewish War Veterans Post #35 as an organization to be commended publicly for its patriotic and charitable services to all persons; now therefore be it
