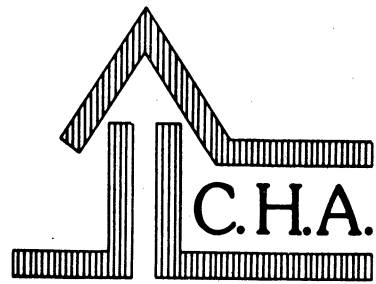

NOT FIRST COME FIRST SERVED

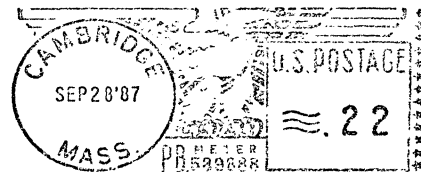
Within each of the above preference categories, a waiting list will be established by LOTTERY. THE APPLICATIONS ARE NOT BEING TAKEN ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. You may apply at any time during the application period (see dates and times above) and receive equal consideration. The waiting list will remain in effect for ONLY one year after which new applications will be taken. You must file a separate application for this program even if you have previously filed for other CHA housing programs. If you have applied for Public Housing the status of your application will not be affected.
