- WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council voted several years ago to receive action alert requests from Amnesty International on behalf of prisoners of conscience, and pursuant thereto has adopted many resolutions on behalf of prisoners of conscience and forwarded such resolutions to the appropriate officials; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council has been requested by Amnesty International, Group 36, of Cambridge, to declare December 10 as "International Human Rights Day"; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That December 10th be declared "International Human Rights Day" in the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the citizens of this city are urged to consider on that day how each citizen individually can act personally to reduce the cruel and unnecessary suffering of mankind.
