lows to wit: Said parcel is of a triangular form, and
is bounded North Easterly by Main Street; Southerly
by Arrow Street; and North Westerly by land of ^{Israel P.} Dun-
ham, there measuring twenty-three feet and eight-tenths.
Being the parcel of land lying between said Main
and Arrow Streets, at their intersection. Said land
is conveyed subject to the following restriction, that
the same shall be suitably enclosed and forever
unoccupied by any building thereon.
