An Ordinance

in relation to the Water Works.

As is ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Section 13. of Chapter 29 of the Revised
Ordinances is hereby amended by striking
out, near the end of said section, the
words "and the balance of the account
on that day" - and inserting in place
thereof the words "and so much of the
balance of said account, after deducting
all expenses and charges of distribution,
as shall be equal to three per centum of
the par value of the then outstanding
water-bonds."
