WHEREAS: These trees are the property and jurisdiction of the City of Cambridge, which have been placed along the Avenue for beautification, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take the appropriate steps to instruct all businessmen to refrain from cutting down any trees in front of their property belonging to the City of Cambridge and to replace those trees already removed, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to compile a list of all violators with a view towards prosecution where warranted.
