It was with profound sorrow that this City Council learned of the passing of Patrick F. Ready, former Chief of the Cambridge Police Department on April 27, 1970, and

WHEREAS:-

Patrick F. Ready was a distinguished son of North Cambridge who entered the Police Department on January 1, 1916 and rose through the ranks and achieved the rank of Captain January 16, 1947, and

WHEREAS:-

Patrick F. Ready was an outstanding police officer who received many commendations for bravery and earned the respect of his fellow officers for his courage in times of stress and was feared by those who broke the laws that he was sworn to enforce, and

WHEREAS:-

Patrick F. Ready achieved the highest honor that a man could attain in the Department by being appointed Chief of the Cambridge Police Department in 1951 and added to his many honors by the organization and development of an outstanding detective bureau which achieved state wide fame in the apprehension of law breakers prior to his retirement in 1957, and

WHEREAS:-

His passing will be sorely felt by the members of his family and his many friends and associates, therefore be it

That the Council of the City of Cambridge in regular session assembled on this 13th day of May does hereby express its sincere sympathy to the members of Mr. Ready's family in their bereavement and adjourns this meeting in honor and in memory of Patrick F.
