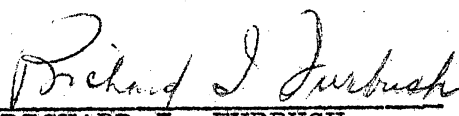

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

It is the intention of this Commission to proceed with the provisions of that portion of Chapter 554 of the Acts of 1962 which authorizes and directs the M.D.C. "to construct an overpass or underpass and necessary approaches thereto on Memorial Drive in the City of Cambridge at River Street, at Western Avenue and at Boylston Street, in order to relieve congestion, to expedite the flow of vehicular traffic and to promote the public safety."

In connection therewith the Commission, at its meeting held today, voted to hold a public hearing on Friday, January 31, 1964 at 10:00 A.M. at its Administrative Offices, 5th Floor, 20 Somerset Street, Boston.

The purpose of this public hearing is to give all interested parties an opportunity to present their views, offer suggestions or ask questions relating to the initial, tentative plans and recommendations which are to be presented at the hearing by the Commission's engineering consultants, Jackson and Moreland, Inc., and their traffic consultants, Bruce Campbell and Associates.
